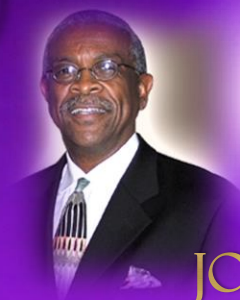

## BISHOP JOHNNY TATES

Bishop Johnny Tates is a native Houstonian. He is married to Sister Lee M. Tates. They have one son, Pastor Patrick Joubert, one daughter, Sis. Chontae Tates-Shirley and five grandchildren. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering Technology in 1969, a Master's in Secondary Education Leadership in 1971 with designation for the Secondary Principalship and a Master's in Municipal Planning and Public Policy in 1973. He also is a 1975 graduate of C.H. Mason Bible College and a 1979 graduate of the Moody Bible Institute School of Theology.

He was saved and dedicated his life to the Lord in May, 1979, and was called to the gospel ministry in May of 1983. He was ordained an Elder in the Church of God in Christ in July 1986, by the late Bishop Robert E. Woodard, Sr. He is the second pastor at the Powerhouse COGIC in Houston, where he now serves as Senior Pastor. He was ordained an Auxiliary Bishop in Texas Southeast First in November 2016 by Presiding Bishop Charles E. Blake, Sr. and affirmed as Jurisdictional Prelate of the newly sanctioned 'Texas Greater Southeast First Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction' [TGSE-1] at the COGIC's 110<sup>th</sup> Holy Convocation in November 2017, in St. Louis, MO.

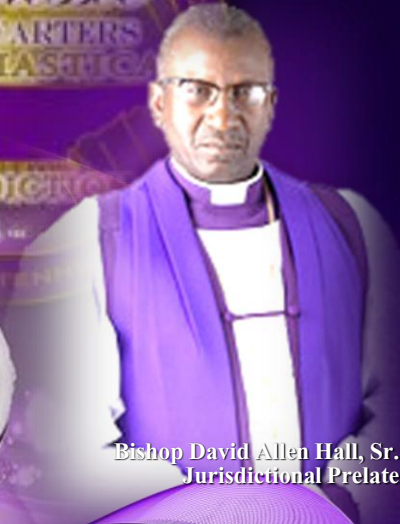
